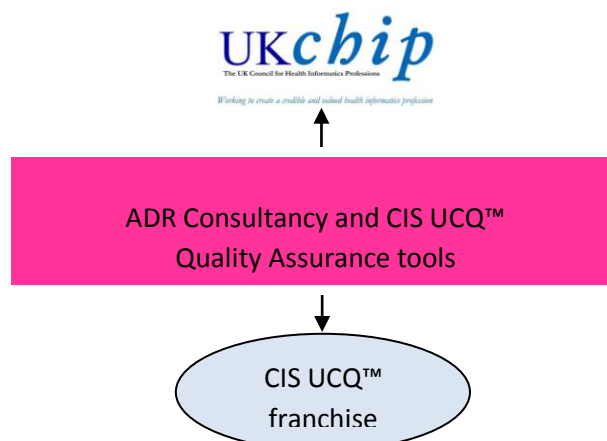
### How does Franchising CIS UCQ™ work?

**STEP 1** Training provider becomes a CIS UCQ™ franchise (choose from 3 option packs).

Franchises will need to demonstrate standards and protocol to receive the tools and training to establish the programme and deliver CIS UCQ™ programmes of your choice, or from the CIS UCQ™ framework).

**STEP 2** A CIS UCQ™ franchised training provider delivers 1 training session to 10 - 12 delegates charging a minimum fee per head for the CIS UCQ™ module (of which the Franchise keeps 70%)

**STEP 3** Submit your learner's results to ADR consultancy which will process certificates.



## What do UKCHIP do?

The UK Council for Health Informatics Professional (UKCHIP) validate that CIS is fit for purpose and supports informatics standards of practice both on quality, design and delivery to the end user. It is expected that in return for its recognition the sponsor receives revenues of which are retained to pay for the upkeep of records, relationships and maintaining the programme credibility both with awarding organisations and the industry.

## What will the participating University do?

Swansea University can identify suitable educational pathways with those individuals who achieve passes in their CIS UCQ™ modules. For example the MSc in Healthcare Informatics. Candidates will be able to explore suitable development opportunities including CPD and degree level studies up to Masters level.
